

# 1ST ANNUAL MIDWEST JURIED ART EXHIBIT

## 2022 PROSPECTUS

### ELIGIBILITY

The Hamilton County Artists' Association is pleased to announce the **1st Annual Midwest Juried Art Exhibit, March 1 – March 26, 2022**. This fine art competition is open to artists 18 years and older who are residents of Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, South Dakota, or Wisconsin. Each entrant may submit up to three (3) works, which must be: original works of art created within the last two (2) years, not completed under instruction and not have won any awards at any other juried competition. Accepted mediums include: oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastels, charcoal, pencil, ink, and mixed media. *NO digital art or photography.*

### ENTRY FEE

- \$30 for non-members
  - \$15 for HCAA members
- Entry fee is **non-refundable**. Limit up to three (3) works.

### ENTRIES DUE

All works must be submitted via the electronic application by **February 1st**. Entries will not be considered complete until payment has been made. Entrants will be notified of acceptance by email by **February 10th**.

### SIZE LIMITATIONS

- Length or width may not exceed 48 inches
- No work of art may exceed 100 lbs. in weight

### FRAMING & PRESENTATION

- All entries must be prepared for installation.
- All work must be framed and wired for hanging.
- No saw-tooth hangers permitted.
- No installation pieces accepted.

### ACCEPTED WORKS

Accepted works must be dropped off at the HCAA Gallery (195 S. 5<sup>th</sup> St, Noblesville, IN) on **February 26th**. If shipping is necessary, please contact Stephanie Spay (stephspayart@gmail.com) for instructions. Works must remain for the duration of the exhibition and must

be picked up **March 26, 2022**, during normal gallery hours (10am-6pm). All work not claimed by April 31, 2022, will automatically be considered the property of the Hamilton County Artists' Association to dispose of in any way it sees fit.

### SALE OF WORK

- All work must be for sale.
- The HCAA will take a commission of 20% on all work sold throughout the duration of the exhibit.

### JUROR: Wyatt LeGrand

Wyatt LeGrand is an award winning painter from Bloomfield, Indiana. He currently works from his hometown studio and teaches grades 7-12 at Bloomfield Jr/Sr High School. After graduating high school in 2005, Wyatt made the short journey to Indiana University, where he attained a degree in visual arts education four years later.

### AWARDS (SELECTED BY JUROR)

\$1000 BEST of SHOW Award, plus additional cash prizes for MERIT Awards for BEST in categories, determined by the Juror. PEOPLES CHOICE AWARD will be selected by the Patrons throughout the duration of the exhibit.
